On Tuesday, Feb. 2, we celebrate the Presentation of the Lord.

The Presentation of Jesus in the temple shows Him to be the firstborn Son who belongs to the Lord. With Simeon and Anna, all Israel awaits its

encounter with the Savior-the name given to this event in the Byzantine tradition. Jesus is recognized as the long-expected Messiah, the “light of the nations” and the “glory of Israel,” but also “a sign that is spoken against.” The sword of sorrow predicted for Mary announces Christ’s perfect and unique oblation on the cross that will impart the salvation God has “prepared in the presence of all peoples” (CCC, no. 529).

A servers’ meeting will be Monday, Feb. 1, at 6:00pm, in church. I ask all servers to be present.

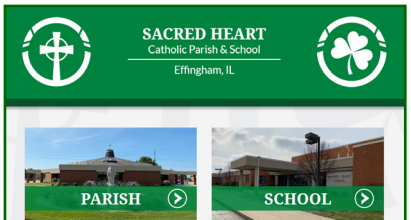


Please join me for Adoration on Monday, Feb. 1, at 7:00pm, in church. This is a great opportunity to spend time in prayer.

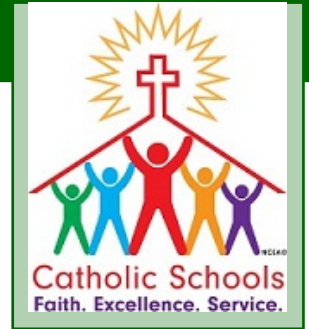

The application form has instructions on submission of the application.
